



New and Updated Functionality in Service Release version 4.50.2:

Service release version 4.50.2 addresses a number of issues that have been discovered in the Mockshop software applications. It also delivers a number of features which have been requested by users.

New Features Added in 4.50.2:

vrImport	csv file of import errors can be produced
Feature ID: 260	A csv file can be produced in response to any errors found during an import. The file includes the fields used in the import, a Date/Time stamp and the error message.
vrFilmroll (floating)	Ability to filter a floating filmroll by style number
Feature ID: 261	Using a right mouse click, the floating filmroll can now be filtered by style number. When the filter is selected the user is presented with a list of style numbers in the floating filmroll. When one is selected, the floating filmroll will only show options that match the style number. When the filter is cleared, the filmroll reverts back to displaying all options.
Licencing	We have implemented UTC time checking
Feature ID: 272	An issue was discovered with our licencing system when users were logging into a citrix server from different time zones. We have now implemented UTC time checking to resolve this.
vrStore	Departments statistics exported to new table
Feature ID: 273	When statistics are exported from vrStore the department details are exported to a new table called Store_departments.
vrExport	Ability to export data as well as images
Feature ID: 268	We have added the ability to export text data to a csv file.



Defects Resolved:

vrImport	A data item of “ “ for a list resulted in the record not being imported.
Feature ID: 264	When a list data item was being imported and the data was a “ “ (space inside quotation marks) the record failed to import. This has been resolved so that the record will import without a value being set for the list.
vrStore	Departments are visible through options and fixtures when a transparent material is applied to them.
Defect ID: 412	When a transparent material was applied to a department it could still be seen through fixtures and options. The rendering sequence has now been changed so this no longer happens.
vrStoryboard	vrStoryboard could be made to crash under certain conditions
Incident ID: 673	It was discovered that vrStoryboard could be made to crash by adding and removing an option from an option placeholder, then inserting a new page and applying a storyboard template to it. This has now been rectified.
vrStoryboard	Applying an option template & sizes to multiple options didn't work correctly
Incident ID: 634	When multiple options were selected and a template or size was applied, only one of the selected options were changed. This has now been rectified.
vrStoryboard	Option labels are not moving when set to scale with garment
Incident ID: 407	<p>When the option of 'scale with garment image' was selected, so that labels moved depending on the size of the image, it was found that they were not scaling. This has now been rectified.</p> <p>The menu option has been changed to read 'Scale with Parent Image', as scalable labels can be added to other types of options besides garments.</p> <p>The objects now able to scale a label are options, images and OLE objects. The default is now set to 'Fixed Size' rather than 'Scale with Parent Image'.</p>

We sincerely hope that these modifications help make using Mockshop a more pleasurable experience. We are continuously developing our software and greatly appreciate feedback from our users.
